In April 2021, our daugther was hospitalized for over a week with MISC-C, a complication that can arise from a COVID infection in children. Our family had mild infections in March. Whales are her favorite animal. Then, in the fall of 2021, my FIL and grandmother-in-law both were hospitalized with bad cases of COVID. Grandma died in November, at the age of 92. My FIL came home for a few days, but had to go back to the hospital due to a secondary pneumonia infection. He died in December. We are grieving, but are comforted by our faith and community.
