

Objective:

-Create a visual design interpreting a story or first hand account of another person's experience during the COVID pandemic. -Image must be in a square ratio, utilizing varying values and hues of blues or reds. (example template below), exported in jpeg or svg format.



This is a sample template.

The red area will be filled with red images. The blue area must be filled with blue images. There will be slight variations across the top (not a "true square"), and on the bottom of the red box, from piece to piece. The ratio of red to blue will also vary. Please leave a little extra space in the design to accommodate this.

If participants are willing, designers and storytellers can be connected to collaborate on the design interpretation.I will translate the images into patterns for volunteers to stitch.

"This is a portrait of my Uncle Joe, taken from a photograph a few years ago. He tested positive for coronavirus on April 11, 2020, and suddenly the stitches I had been making to try to hold space for thousands of people I do not know became personal. Joe died from COVID on April 13. He was a teacher for most of his life, a navy veteran, a man who loved to kid around with his nieces and nephews. In this photo, he's wearing a baseball hat from his extensive collection, from the golf course he frequented and worked for after he retired from teaching."
